2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

3. CONSENT AGENDA

4. OLD BUSINESS

5. **NEW BUSINESS**

- 5.1 Adoption of the Canadian Safe Sport Program
- Myles Spencer and Kelly Laframboise provided an overview of the program and the mandatory requirement for all CSC members to sign consent annually.
- Key takeaways:
 - The Safe Sport Program will now be delivered by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport.





- Commonwealth Games Association of Canada is a federally funded sport organization and is required to adopt the Canadian Safe Sport Program as a policy.
- o All members must complete e-learning and sign consent by April 1, 2025.
- The requirement applies to all, including non-voting directors.

Motion moved by Myles Spencer; seconded by Rob Adams

"Be it resolved, that Commonwealth Games Association of Canada formally accepts and adopts the Canadian Safe Sport program."

5.2 <u>United Canada 2030 Commonwealth Games Bid Strategies</u>

- Brian MacPherson and Claire Carver-Dias outlined the three-point strategy for securing the bid:
 - 1. Engaging provincial and territorial governments
 - 2. Political outreach at federal and provincial levels
 - 3. Increasing public awareness and support
- Updates: Multiple provinces (e.g., Manitoba, Nova Scotia, Ontario) are reviewing participation but have not formally committed.
- Political engagement efforts are ongoing, with Ontario showing positive interest.

5.3 Sport for Newcomers – Corporate Partner Recruitment

- Pradeep Sood provided an update on fundraising for the Sport for Newcomers program:
 - o A corporate sponsorship approach is being pursued.
 - A new pitch deck and promotional video have been developed with a \$10,000 budget.
 - Members are encouraged to leverage personal and professional networks to secure corporate sponsorships.
 - o Brian MacPherson and Ryan are leading the corporate outreach effort.

5.4 Finances

- Sport Canada Funding:
 - o CSC has applied for needs-based funding under a new federal model.
 - Uncertainty exists about the 2025-2026 budget, with an expected update from Sport Canada in March 2025.
 - Possibilities: funding could increase, decrease, or remain at the current level of \$385,000 annually.
- Sponsorship Updates:
 - o PCL and Kukri have renewed sponsorships for 2026 Team Canada.
 - Gowling Canada declined to renew, citing a lack of UK business ties.
 - However, Gowling Canada has shown interest in supporting the Sport for Newcomers program.
 - Potential funding opportunity from the Hamilton Community Foundation, flagged by Greg Maychak.



- Budgeting Delay:
 - CSC will postpone its annual budget meeting until government funding levels are confirmed.

6. OTHER

The next meeting date is unknown - sometime in April or May after we have been informed of our funding levels.

7. IN CAMERA

The Board of Directors conducted a regularly schedule In-Camera meeting.
